

Raglan Yoke Turtleneck

Skill Level: Intermediate
Yarn Weight: #4

SIZES

- Pullover is sized to fit Women's Small (Medium, Large, X-Large). Hat is sized to fit most adults.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Bust 35 (38½, 41½, 45)"
- Length 23 (25, 26½, 27½)"
- Upper Arm 13½ (14¼, 15, 16¼)"

MATERIALS

- 6 (6, 7, 7) 100g (164 yd) hanks **S R Kertzer Sable Soft** (50% super wash wool, 50% acrylic) color #210 Old Rose (MC)
- 1 (1, 2, 2) 100g (164 yd) hanks **S R Kertzer Sable Soft** (50% super wash wool, 50% acrylic) color #220 Hazy Purple (A)
- 1, 100g (164 yd) hank **S R Kertzer Sable Soft** (50% superwash wool, 50% acrylic) color #212 Copenhagen (B)
- Size 8 US (5mm) 32" circular needles
- Size 9 US (5.5mm) 32" circular needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- 5, Size 8 US (5mm) double pointed needles
- 5, Size 9 US (5.5mm) double pointed needles
- stitch holders, locking stitch markers, ring stitch markers

GAUGE

- 15 sts x 20 rnds = 4" in St st with larger ndls
- TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.



PULLOVER BODY

With smaller circular ndls and MC, CO 132 (144, 156, 168)sts. Join in round being careful not to twist and PM on first st. Work in 2x2 rib until piece meas 1½" from CO. Change to larger circular ndls and knit 2 rnds.

Establish Pattern

Next rnd: Cont St st in the Rnd (knit every rnd) and beg Chart 2, working the 6-st repeat 22 (24, 26, 28) times. With MC, cont even in St st in the Rnd until piece meas 15 (16, 17, 17)" from CO.

Divide for Armhole

Next rnd: K4, slip these 4 sts and last 4 sts of previous round onto first st holder for first armhole. K66 (72, 78, 84) sts. Slip last 8 sts just worked onto second st holder for armhole. Knit to end of round. Do not break yarn. Set aside on needles.

SLEEVES

With smaller dpns and MC, CO 36 (36, 40, 40) sts. Divide evenly onto 4 ndls [9 (9, 10, 10) sts each]. Join in round and PM on first st. Work in 2x2 rib until piece meas 1½" from CO.

Shape Sleeve

Change to larger dpns and knit 1 round, inc 2 (2, 4, 4) sts evenly across [38 (38, 44, 44) sts]. Knit 1 round. Cont in St st in the Rnd (knit every rnd) and beg Chart 2, working to end of chart. Cont in MC, **while at the same time**, inc 1 st at beg and end of next and every foll of 10th (8th, 10th, 8th) rnd 5 (7, 6, 8) times [50 (54, 58, 62) sts, incorporating new sts into Chart 2 pat as they appear. Work even in rnds until piece meas 17 (17½, 18, 18)" from CO. **Next rnd:** K4, slip these 4 sts and last 4 sts of previous round onto a st holder. Break yarn leaving tail approx. 12" long for grafting at underarm. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Join Sleeves to Body

Returning to Body on larger circ ndls, with MC, K42 (46, 50, 54) sts from Sleeve, pm, K58 (64, 70, 76) sts from Body, pm, K42 (46, 50, 54) sts from second Sleeve, pm, K58 (64, 70, 76) sts from Body, pm [200 (220, 240, 260) sts].

YOKE

Next rnd: *K1, K2tog, K to 3 sts before m, skp,

K1, slm; rep from * to end of rnd. Work 3 rnds even. Rep last 4 rounds twice more [176 (196, 216, 236) sts]. **Next rnd:** *K1, K2tog, K to 3 sts before m, skp, K1, slm; rep from * to end of rnd. Work 1 round even. Rep last 2 rnds 13 (15, 17, 19) times more, changing to larger dpns or shorter circ ndl as required [64 (68, 72, 76) sts].

NECKBAND

Change to smaller dpns and work in 1x1 rib for 3". Change to larger dpns. Bring yarn to front between ndls, slip first st of next rnd as if to purl, wrap this st by bringing the yarn to back between needles and return slipped st to left needle. Turn pullover inside out so that the WS is facing. **Next rnd (RS):** Purl, inc 8 sts evenly across [72 (76, 80, 84) sts]. Knit 1 rnd. Beg Chart 1, working the 2-st rep 36 (38, 40, 42) times. After completing Chart 1, cont with MC, knit 1 round. Work 1 round in 2x2 rib. BO all sts loosely in rib.

FINISHING

Graft sleeves at underarm. Block to measurements.

HAT

With smaller dpns and MC, CO 84 sts. Divide evenly onto 4 ndls [21 sts each]. Join to work in

the rnd and pm on first st. Work 4 rows in 2x2 rib until piece mea 1½" from CO. Change to larger dpns and knit 2 rounds.

Establish Pattern

Next rnd: Cont in St st in the Rnd (knit every round) and beg Chart 2, working 6-st rep 14 times. With MC, work even in St st in the Rnd until piece meas 6½" from CO.

Shape Crown

Next (dec) rnd: *K2tog, K5; rep from * to end of rnd [72 sts]. **Next (eyelet) rnd:** *K2, yo, K2tog, K2; rep from * to end of rnd. Cont St st in the rnd 2" from eyelet rnd. Work 1 rnd in 2x2 rib. BO in rib.

Tie

Cut two 80" strands of MC. With both strands held together, hold one end and with someone holding the other end, twist the strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold the 2 ends together and tie in a knot so that they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves together. Thread cord through eyelet holes and tie as in photo.

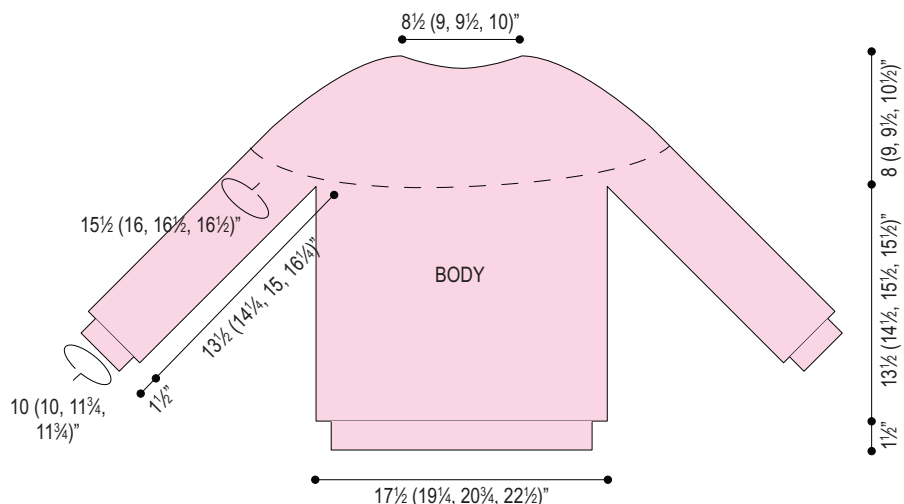
