## KNIT 'N STYLE FREE ONLINE PATTERN

### BACK

With larger needles, CO 77 (81, 87, 93, 99, 103) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*P1, K1; Rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** P1, \*K1, P1; Rep from \* across, inc 1 st at end – 78 (82, 88, 94, 100, 104) sts.

**Row 3:** P 1 (3, 1, 4, 2, 4), K6, \*P4, K6; Rep from \* to last 1 (3, 1, 4, 2, 4) sts, P to end.

**Row 4:** K the K sts and P the P sts as they face you. Rep Rows 3 & 4 until piece meas 4½" from CO, end WSR. Inc 1 st at each end of the next row, every 1½" three times, then every 1¾" twice, working incs into K6, P4 ribbing as sts become available – 90 (94, 100, 106, 112, 116) sts. Work even until piece meas 13½" from CO, end WSR. Mark beg and end of last row for beg of armholes.

### Shape Armholes

**Dec Row:** K2, K2SP, work to last 5 sts, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K2. Rep Dec Row every RSR 5 times more – 66 (70, 76, 82, 88, 92) sts. Work even in ribbing as est until armholes meas 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7, 7½)", end WSR.

**Inc Row (RS):** K2, M1k, work to last 2 sts, M1k, K2. Rep Inc Row every 1" once more – 70 (74, 80, 86, 92, 96) sts. Work even in ribbing as est until armholes meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½)", end WSR.

### Shape Shoulders and Neck

BO 6 (6, 7, 8, 9, 8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

**Next row (RS):** BO 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts, work until there are 6 (7, 8, 8, 9, 10) sts on RH ndl, join a new yarn end, BO center 36 (36, 36, 40, 40, 42) sts, work to end. BO 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of the next 3 rows and *AT THE SAME TIME*, dec 1 st at each neck edge EVERY row once.

### FRONT

Work same as for Back until armholes meas 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7, 7½)" end WSR – 66 (70, 76, 82, 88, 92) sts.

### Shape Neck

**Next row (RS):** K2, M1k, work until there are 23 (25, 28, 29, 32, 33) sts on RH ndl, join a new yarn end, BO center 22 (22, 22, 26, 26, 28) sts, work to last 2 sts, M1k, K2. Working both sides at once, dec 1 st each neck edge every RSR 8 times while *AT THE SAME TIME*, cont to shape armholes same as for Back. When armholes meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½)", end WSR. BO 6 (6, 7, 8, 9, 8) sts each armhole edge once, then 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9) sts twice for shoulders.

### SLEEVES

With larger needles, CO 50 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** P3, K4, \*P6, K4; Rep from \* to last 3 sts, end P3.

**Row 2:** K the K sts and P the P sts as they face you. Rep these 2 rows until sleeve meas 5" from CO, end WSR.

**Next row (RS):** K3, P4, \*K6, P4; Rep from \* to last 3 sts, end K3.

This reverses the rib pat for the cuff. Work even in ribbing as est until sleeve meas 10" from CO, end WSR. Inc 1 st at each end of next row. Rep this inc every 4 rows 0 (0, 0, 0, 5, 14) times more, every 6 rows 0 (0, 0, 12, 10, 4) times, every 8 rows 0 (0, 10, 1, 0, 0) times, every 10 rows 2 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0) times, then every 12 rows 5 (5, 0, 0, 0, 0) times, working incs into K6, P4 ribbing – 66 (66, 72, 78, 82, 88) sts. Work even until sleeve meas 22½" from CO, end on WSR. Mark beg and end of last row for beg of cap.

### Shape Sleeve Cap

**Next row (RS):** K2, KSP, K to last 4 sts, ssk, K2. Rep this dec every RSR 16 times more, end WSR. BO 5 (3, 4, 4, 3, 3) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 4 (3, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts at the beg of next 2 rows. BO rem 14 (20, 24, 30, 36, 42) sts.



### SIZES

Pullover sized to fit Women's size X-Small (Small, Medium, Large, X-Large, XX-Large).

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Bust 32 (34, 36, 38, 40, 42)"
- Length 21½ (22, 22½, 23, 23½, 24)"
- Upper Arm 12 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16)"

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### MATERIALS

- 11 (11, 12, 12, 13, 13), 50g (100 yd) hanks **Berocco Softwist** (59% rayon, 41% wool) color Ginger #9439
- Size 8 US needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Size 7 US 16" circular needle (for turtleneck)
- stitch markers

### GAUGE

• 22 sts and 28 rows = 4" over K6, P4 ribbing on larger needles

**Note:** Gauge should be taken after swatch is steamed flat. TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

### DESIGNER NOTES

This garment is designed to fit close to the body. There is quite a bit of stretch due to the nature of the ribbing.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**KSP** K1, then sl st back to LH ndl, lift 2nd st on LH ndl back over returned st and replace returned st on RH ndl (1 st dec'd)

**K2SP** K2tog, then sl st back to LH ndl, lift 2nd st on LH ndl back over returned st and replace returned st on RH ndl (2 sts dec'd)
